- ◆ Where a bowl or vase is stated, no other container is to be used.
- ◆ Points are given for variety in all collections.
- ◆ Wall vase may be any shape.
- ◆ Items to be judged on artistic quality of arrangements.

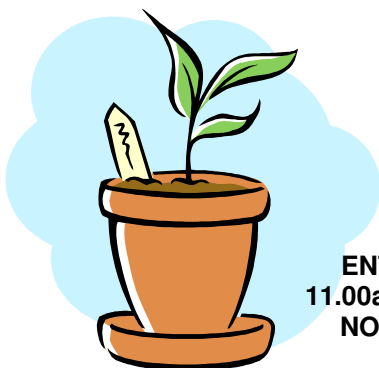
Most Points gained in Pot Plants trophy donated by
